The Cacau Club, a natural-chocolate curation team, will guide visitors through the Amazon rainforest, touring cacao plantations, harvesting plants, trying luxury candies and experiencing curated, personalized culinary menus crafted by skilled chefs.

With the support of five-star hotel Kisawa Sanctuary in Mozambique, travelers will be able to take part in a helicopter flyover of the Bazaruto Archipelago National Marine Park, witnessing the travel of whale pods.

Situated in the heart of the Champagne region, guests will travel to Mareuil-sur-y, France, and experience a tour of the French beverage maker Champagne Billecart-Salmon's estate following a private dinner service hosted by Mathieu Roland Billecart, the company's CEO.

Lastly, in New York, members will be able to attend The Bridge, an invite-only classic car gathering held at the Bridgehampton Race Circuit.
